### Important Information about Arrival and Dismissal for the 2017 – 2018 School Year

#### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- School hours for the 2017 – 2018 school year are 8:10 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. for all Pre-K-5 students. *PreK and kindergarten students have an amended schedule for the first few days of school. Information for incoming kindergarten and PreK students will be sent home.*

**Please note:** Breakfast is served – 7:30 a.m. - 8:00 a.m. daily and is free for all students.

#### Arrival:

1. All students entering the building before 8:00 a.m. must enter through Exit C (the Breakfast Door), Rugby Road & Cortelyou Road, and immediately go to the cafeteria.
2. Students arriving at 8:00 a.m. will be allowed to enter through the main entrance and go directly to their line-up area in the auditorium or gym. Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade students must enter through Exit C for morning line-up.
3. All students must be at their lineup location **by 8:10 to be marked on time**. Students not at their lineup location by 8:10 will be marked late.
